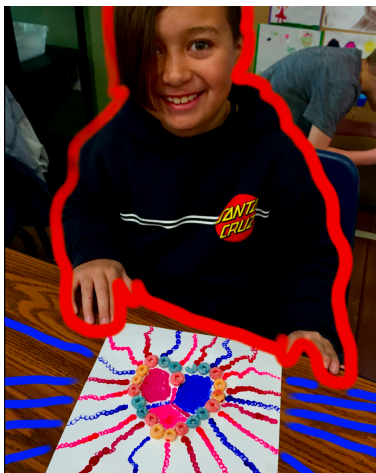


# Sweet ART



Materials:  
paper (card stock works best)  
colorful cereal  
pencil  
glue  
optional:  
Q-tips & acrylic paint  
(Target has a nice selection of small containers of paint if parents happen to be out getting home necessities.)

- 1) Draw a circle, square, triangle, heart (any shape you like) with a pencil. You may trace or free draw your shape. To trace a circle - grab a cup or anything circular.
- 2) Now choose a color pattern with your cereal. Maybe select two - three colors.... what ever you like.
- 3) Slowly add glue to your shape, then place cereal on top.
- 4) While glue is still wet - you can move cereal pieces around to create symmetry and balance.
- 5) Finish by adding bright spots of color with Q-tip dipped in paint (if you have paint at home).
- 6) Let dry, then display.
