STAY HOME FOR NEVADA: Governor orders closure of all nonessential businesses



Governor Sisolak announced that all casinos in the state of Nevada will remain closed for 30 days and that the only businesses that should remain open are those that are essential for the community, such as healthcare providers and businesses that provide food. The only restaurants that are allowed to remain open are those that provide delivery, drive-thru or curbside pickup. The governor stated that only essential services should remain open such as the following: Pharmacies, grocery stores, drug & convenience stores, banks and financial institutions, hardware stores, gas stations, food processing, agriculture, industrial manufacturing, feed mills, construction, trash collection, grocery and household goods (including convenience stores), home repair/hardware and auto repair, pharmacy and other medical facilities, biomedical and healthcare, post offices and shipping outlets, insurance, banks, gas stations, laundromats, veterinary clinics and pet stores, warehousing, storage, and distribution, public transportation, and hotel and commercial lodging.
