



CUBS: Best Kids in the UNIVERSE Bracelet

How to... by Mrs. Stachowski



Materials:

Beads...beads...& beads,
.8 mm stretch cord, scissors,
and a clip
(I use a binder clip).

These little sparkling beads (found
at Discount Beads) remind me of the
planet Mercury.

The gray beads remind me of Pluto.

The aqua colored beads: Uranus.



I use two beads for Saturn. I place a silver bead inside a "ring" bead.

This multi-colored bead reminds me of Jupiter!

The yellow beads remind me of the sun. I want the sun to be bigger than the "planets".

Blue and white - Earth

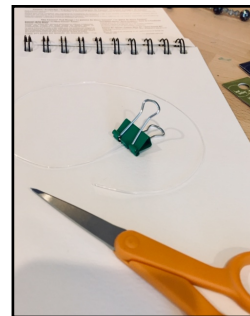
The white beads remind me of the moon, but I want to get the next size down so the moon is smaller than Earth.



The orange beads remind me of Venus.

Red - Mars

Blue - Neptune



START: Cut about 12 inches of stretch magic cord, and place a binder clip on the one end. This way your beads won't fall off.

String beads in order. Check for sizing and add or subtract lava beads to get the length you like.

order: **SUN**, Mercury, Venus, **Earth**, moon, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune, Pluto.

Add any special bead you like to your bracelet.



Tie a basic knot pulling tight, then tie one more time. Snip the ends off. Slip the knot under the nearest bead to hide.
